CAN YOU FIND MOTH PLANT?

Pink and white flowers in summer

Big green seed pods (Feb to May) produce thousands of seeds

Vines can grow to 8 m tall

Has arrow-head shaped leaves, pale underneath

Help us restore Kaipātiki by eradicating this pest



Across the Kaipātiki area, the horrible pest moth plant is flowering and producing its big, green seed pods. If we do nothing, they'll soon burst - sending hundreds of thousands of seeds to land in our back gardens and precious reserves.

If you find moth plant in your garden, remove them immediately!
